


TENNESSEE INVESTMENTS PREPARING SCHOLARS (TIPS)

is a matching grant program encouraging families of qualifying income levels to save for the future cost of college by opening a TNStars College Savings account. TIPS and TNStars are administered by the Tennessee Treasury Department.

4-TO-1 MATCHING GRANT

When a qualifying family opens a TNStars account and enrolls a beneficiary in the TIPS program, the state will provide a 4-to-1 matching contribution to the beneficiary's TNStars account. That's \$100 for every \$25 contributed by the account holder! Beneficiaries can receive a match of \$500 per year, with a lifetime maximum match of \$1,500.



TO QUALIFY FOR TIPS:

- The account holder and beneficiary must be Tennessee residents.
 - The beneficiary must be 14 years of age or younger.
- Families must meet the income eligibility requirements. Visit *treasury.tn.gov/TIPS* for current household income requirements.


HOW DOES TNSTARS WORK TO HELP YOU SAVE FOR COLLEGE?

The TNStars College Savings 529 Program is designed to help families save for future college costs. Contributions to a TNStars account are invested, and the earnings grow tax-free when used for qualified higher education expenses.


